


## Taking a Language Placement test

1. Login to **MyTLU** Portal
2. Under **Quick Links**, see courses you are currently enrolled in. If you requested access to a Spanish Placement test, an appropriate course will appear under **My Courses**. Select either **Spanish or French** placement to access the test site.



3. A new page titled **Spanish Placement** will open up. Click on a **Spanish Placement** link (in **Red box**) to view the test instructions.


